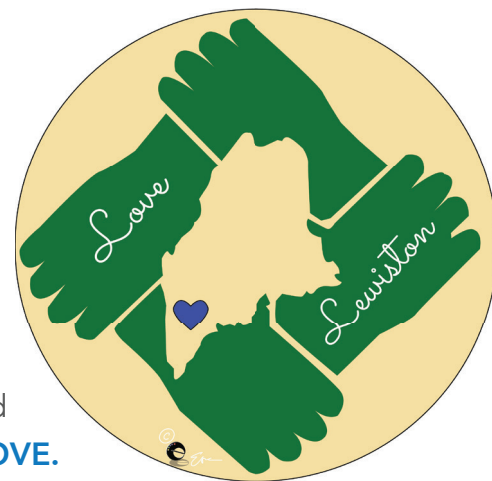


Love Lewiston Day

Share Remembrance Ribbons

Blanket the city of Lewiston with "Remembrance Ribbons" to honor the memory of those lost and to show unity across the community. You can help by tying "Remembrance Ribbons" around each and every telephone pole of the city. Choose your own street, outside your business, or anywhere you see an open pole. There will be bundles of Remembrance Ribbons ready for pick up at Tree Street Youth, in front of Longley School, at Bates College, and also across community businesses
